Notifying the Public of Rights Under Title VI

THE West Baton Rouge Council on Aging, Inc.

- ✓ The West Baton Rouge Council on Aging, Inc. operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, and national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act. Any person who believes she or he has been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint with the **West Baton Rouge Council on Aging, Inc.** and should be filed within 180 days of date of alleged discrimination.
